

Safety Guidelines for a Safe and Happy Outing!

September is a wonderful season for outings. Just as the autumn weather suggests, you will likely see many families on excursions. If you have children, parental vigilance regarding safety is crucial. I am sure that while raising infants and toddlers, you have likely experienced your child disappearing from your sight if you take your eyes off them for even a moment. In particular, infants and toddlers are a period of abundant curiosity; they enjoy observing and exploring their surroundings and attempting active movements. Because their developmental characteristics involve traveling very far in an instant, parental vigilance becomes even more critical during outings. To ensure a happy outing with your children, we are providing information on prevention guidelines for missing children and kidnapping, as well as the pre-registration system for fingerprints. Please refer to this information to ensure a safe trip.

Missing Child and Kidnapping Prevention Guidelines Parents(Guardians) Should Know

- ☐ Pre-register the child's fingerprints and photo, guardian's personal information, etc.
- ☐ Do not leave children at home alone.
- ☐ Always go around with your children.
- ☐ Use child abduction prevention items(anti-mission child bracelets, necklaces, etc.).
- ☐ Please remember information about your child (height, weight, date of birth, physical characteristics, etc.).
- ☐ Get to know your child's daily routine and close friends.
- ☐ Take a photo of your children regularly.

Promises to prevent disappearances and kidnappings in playgrounds and parks!

- ☐ Set a time to get home, and make sure they keep the promise.
- ☐ They don't play alone, but play in groups with friends.
- ☐ Play in bright, well-lit place where a guardian can always keep an eye on them.
- ☐ If someone approaches and tries to lure you in, say "No!" "I don't want to!" shout "Help me!"
- ☐ Never follows strangers!



What to do in case of disappearance

1

Look for at nearby place and contact the information desk or request an announcement at the lost child protection center.

2

112 or 182
Report immediately to the National Police Agency and the Missing Children Search center.

3-Step Missing Child Prevention Relief

1. Stop! If you lose a family member, stop right there and wait!
2. Think! Think about your name, family's names, and phone numbers 10 times each!
3. Please help! If your family doesn't come even after waiting, ask a safe person nearby for help by saying "Please help!"

Pre-register your child's fingerprints, etc.



What is fingerprint and other pre-registration system?

A system designed to locate missing children more quickly by pre-registering information, such as fingerprints, photos, and guardian contact details, into the police system and utilizing the registered data in the event of a disappearance.



How to pre-register fingerprints, etc.

You can register by visiting a nearby police station or from home via mobile Safety DREAM app..
